Standard Open Burning Conditions:

This permit shall be retained by the applicant and shall be shown upon request of appropriate officials without delay. All open burning operations shall be subject to inspection by the local authorities.

During publicly announced fire restrictions / bans made by Elbert County, all permits are suspended in alert areas.

At no time shall the burn be left unattended. Burning shall be supervised by one or more responsible persons depending on the type of burning. Precautions shall be taken to localize the burning and in no way constitute a fire hazard to persons or property within or adjacent to the area of burning. The granting authority and the employees or agents thereof, in the issuing of a permit, do not assume any responsibility or results in damage to the person or property of the permittee, or the person or property of any third kind. The permit holder is responsible for following all EPA, State, and County Regulations concerning the disposal of hazardous materials and waste.

Burning shall be restricted to the items(s) and location identified in the permit.
