RESOLUTION NO. 13-0510

RESOLUTION OF THE AGATE FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT TO ESTABLISH COST RECOVERY POLICY

WHEREAS, CRS §32-1-1002(1)(e) allows the governing body of a fire protection district to fix fees and charges to recover costs for certain emergency and/or medical services associated with motor vehicle accidents within the established boundaries of the district; and

WHEREAS, CRS §32-1-1002 allows for cost recovery of fire departments for fire suppression, rescue, medical, and/or emergency services provided outside the established boundaries of the district: and

WHEREAS, It has been an established policy and practice of Agate Rural Volunteer Fire Department prior to the transition to Agate Fire Protection District (AFPD) to recover cost of emergency and/or medical services resulting from motor vehicle accidents from non-residents of the district who are the liable party.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Agate Fire Protection District:

- 1. That the AFPD will continue the policy as established by Agate Rural Volunteer Fire Department prior to transition to Agate Fire Protection District to recover costs associated with emergency and/or medical services provided at motor vehicle accidents from at fault parties who are non-residents of the district.
- 2. To recover costs for fire, rescue, and/or medical services from all at fault parties of motor vehicle accidents responded to that are outside the established boundaries of the district.
- 3. To recover costs on behalf of departments that provide mutual and/or automatic aid to motor vehicle accidents associated with fire, emergency, and medical services within the established boundaries of AFPD.
- 4. To recover costs associated with fire suppression, emergency, and/or medical services while providing mutual and/or automatic aid outside the established boundaries of the district, if the primary district does not initiate the cost recovery on behalf of AFPD.
